#### IMMUNIZATION NOTIFICATION FOR ENROLLMENT

## Mandated School Requirements:

# NRS 392.435 Immunization of pupils

Unless excused because of religious belief or medical condition, a child <u>may NOT</u> be enrolled in a public school within this State unless his parent or guardian submit to the board of trustees of the school district in which the child resides a certificate stating that the child has been immunized and has received proper boosters for that immunization or is complying with the schedules established pursuant to NRS 439.550 for the following diseases:

- 5.DTap/DAP (Minimum age: 6 weeks) if series was started before age 7
- 2 Hepatitis A (Minimum age: 12 Months)
- 3 Hepatitis B (Minimum age: birth)
- 2 MMR (Minimum age: 12 Months)
- 1 MCV4 (Meningococcal) (Minimum age: 10 YEARS) Required for 7th grade enrollment after June 30, 2017 (and students new to the District between 8th and 12th grade)
- 4 Polio/IPV/OPV (Minimum age: 6 weeks)
- 1 Tdap: Required for 7th grade enrollment and all students grade 8th 12th
- <u>2 Varicella/Chicken Pox</u> (Minimum age: 12 Months) Physician verification of past disease required for exemption.

## **ALL IMMUMIZATION RECORDS:**

Authorized school personnel must review each child's immunization record(s) at the time of enrollment. Children must obtain required immunization(s) or sign a medical or religious belief exemption form prior to attending school or they may be excluded until (s)he is compliant with the requirements. If a child requires more than one dose of a specific vaccine, the child may continue to attend school during the minimum interval between doses. In the event of an outbreak of the vaccine-preventable disease, children who are exempt may be excluded until the risk period of exposure ends.
